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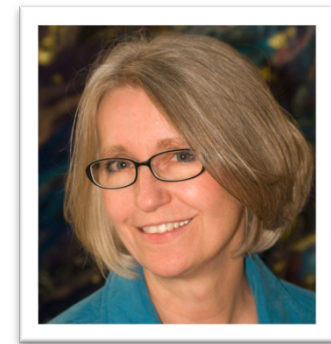

Helping Children with Aided Communication Tools For Success in the Classroom

Students with complex communication needs present interesting challenges within the classroom setting. In attempting to serve our students, we're often faced with the challenge of juggling the demands of a rigorous academic curriculum with the need to continue to establish and expand their language and AAC system use. This workshop focuses on classroom-tested materials and creative and fun strategies for conducting differentiated instruction using a Primary-Secondary Facilitator Model and an interdisciplinary approach. Emphasis will be placed on the seamless integration of technology and the telescoping of academic and therapeutic goals. Although much of the content is classroom-based and reflective of group-based instruction, many of the strategies are equally applicable to one-on-one intervention within a therapy room setting. This workshop should be of interest to teachers, classroom assistants, speech-language pathologists, occupational therapists and parents interested in promoting better academic outcomes for their students. Numerous videotapes will be shown of classroom implementation across a range of subjects.
